No Small Business Set-Asides For FSS Purchases

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GSA has taken the position that GAO's "Rule of Two" established in the *Delex* protest (B-400403, Oct. 8, 2008), which requires an agency to set aside a procurement for small businesses when there are at least two qualified small businesses, does not apply to the Federal Supply Schedule program. <u>GSA issued a memo to this effect on October 28, 2008</u> and recently has been taking efforts to ensure that agencies and FSS contractors understand its rejection of the Rule of Two for FSS purchases.
