## **Crowell & Moring LLP Ranks Among Top 15 *Pro Bono* Firms in *American Lawyer* Report**

**Washington, D.C. - July 5, 2006:** In a survey of the nation's 200 highest-grossing firms, Crowell & Moring LLP ranked 13th in *American Lawyer's* "Pro Bono Report," which was based on the most recent "AmLaw 200" survey of that magazine.
