Washington – March 12, 2019: The Burton Awards committee of judges has awarded Crowell & Moring LLP partners [Scott L. Winkelman](#), John S. Gibson, and [Rebecca Baden Chaney](#), along with HP, Inc. division counsel Jennifer A. Prioleau, its “2019 *Law360* Distinguished Legal Writing Award” for an article entitled “[Seven Ways to Prepare Your Legal Department for the Fourth Industrial Revolution](#),” published in *ACC Docket*. The award honors exceptional legal writing and recognizes 30 articles from entries submitted by the nation's 1,000 largest law firms.
