Crowell & Moring Ranked Among Top Section 337 U.S. ITC Firms in Patexia's 2021 ITC Intelligence Report

Washington – April 1, 2021: Patexia has named Crowell & Moring a “Most Active” and “Best Performing” law firm for Section 337 unfair import investigations before the U.S. International Trade Commission in its 2021 ITC Intelligence Report.

The firm was ranked one of the Top 15 Best Performing Law Firms overall based on outcome for its clients before the Commission, including a Top 10 ranking representing respondents.
