# New York City Bar Association Names Juan Arteaga a 2019 Diversity & Inclusion Champion

**New York – May 9, 2019:** The New York City Bar Association has awarded [Juan A. Arteaga](#), a partner in Crowell & Moring’s Antitrust and White Collar & Regulatory Enforcement groups, its 2019 Diversity & Inclusion Champion Award.

The association created the Diversity and Inclusion Award in 2006 to recognize leaders who have played a role in creating opportunities for traditionally underrepresented groups within their organizations and the overall New York legal community.

Along with Arteaga, Lisa Linsky, a partner at McDermott Will & Emery LLP, will also be presented with the award at the association’s Diversity and Inclusion Celebration Dinner on June 26 in New York.
