

Regis University Names Crowell & Moring's Meshach Rhoades to Athletics Hall of Fame

Denver – August 9, 2022: Regis University named Crowell & Moring's Meshach Rhoades to the Regis Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2022. This year's class is all-female in honor of the 50th anniversary of Title IX.

In announcing the recognition, the university described Rhoades as “not only dependable and durable, but also a sensational playmaker,” as well as “a staple for Regis women's basketball during her four years, starting a school record 111 games.”
