<a href="#"><u>Executive Order 13662 (Sectoral Sanctions)*</u></a>  <i>Further expands the scope of the national emergency of the actions and policies of the Gov't of the Russian Federation, including its purported annexation of Crimea and its use of force in Ukraine, which continue to undermine democratic processes and institutions in Ukraine; threaten its peace, security, stability, sovereignty, and territorial integrity; and contribute to the misappropriation of its assets.</i>	Mar 20, 2014	Mar 2, 2018	Mar 1, 2019
