28	under a policy or District law for a claim of physical loss of property shall by tolled from the
29	beginning of the period of a public health emergency declared pursuant to section 5a of the
30	District of Columbia Public Emergency Act of 1980, effective October 17, 2002 (D.C. Law 14-
31	194; D.C. Official Code § 7-2304.01) ("Public Health Emergency"), until the end of the public
32	health emergency, and for 90 days thereafter.

(b) For the purposes of this section, the term "physical loss of property" shall include loss
of use of property, loss of occupancy, property damage, and lost income, incurred expenses, and
other business interruption losses.
