All applications must include:

- resume
- law school and undergraduate transcripts (unofficial is acceptable)
- legal writing sample
- and a brief (500 words or less) personal statement discussing your qualifications and commitment to promoting diversity in the legal profession or why diversity and inclusion is important to you
