Re: Sugar from Mexico: Request for Continuation of Investigations

Dear Secretary Pritzker:

On behalf of AmCane Sugar LLC, we hereby request continuation of the above-referenced antidumping and countervailing duty investigations, which were initiated on April 17, 2014 and suspended by Commerce on December 19, 2014.¹

The statute, at 19 U.S.C. §§ 1671c(g)(2) and 1673c(g)(2), entitles certain “interested parties,” if registered as a “party to the investigation,” to request (and thereby trigger) continuation. As a producer in the United States of a domestic product that is like the subject imported merchandise, AmCane qualifies under 19 U.S.C. §1677(9)(C) as an “interested party” of the kind entitled to request

continuation. AmCane is also a “party to the investigation,” having entered an appearance and filed comments on the proposed suspension agreements.

This request is timely filed within 20 days of the December 29, 2014 “date of publication of the notice of suspension of the investigation.”² In accordance with 19 C.F.R. §351.208(h), we are concurrently notifying the U.S. International Trade Commission of this request for continuation.

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
